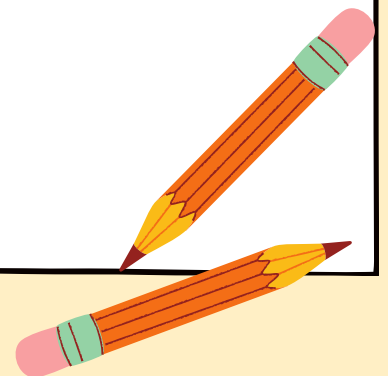


# HLNA French Transition Booklet

For your transition task -

You will have the choice between two options both centred around food.

Each option will also have the main task (10 house points) and a Challenge task (5 extra house points)

### Option 1

## Instructions

### Option 1

Choose 1 of the recipes provided.

In French and create a shopping list for the recipe in English.

Then research how much money each item on your shopping list will cost.

Translate the recipe into English using the online French - English Collins dictionary to help you.

### Challenge task

Make the recipe that you choose and give it your own twist.

For example: Come up with a filling for your crêpe and then make it and take some pictures of you making it and also of the finished product. You could even choose one of the sentences below to say if you liked them or not and why. But what do you think they mean?

Eg. J'aime ça parce que c'est super!

Je n'aime pas ça parce que c'est mauvais!

Pour environ 30 crêpes:



500 grammes de farine

4 oeufs

1 litre de lait

2 cuillères à soupe d'huile

1 pincée de sel

Dans un récipient, mélange tous les ingrédients avec un fouet.

Fais cuire à la poêle ou dans une crêpière avec un petit morceau de beurre.

Verse un peu de pâte dans la poêle chaude avec une louche.

Laisse dorer pendant quelques secondes, puis retourne la crêpe.

Sers avec de la confiture ou du Nutella. Miam-miam!



## Pour 4 Crôte-monsieurs



8 tranches de pain

4 tranches de jambon

100 grammes de fromage râpé

50 grammes de beurre

Beurre 4 tranches de pain sur une face.

Pose une tranche de jambon sur la face non-beurrée.

Soupoudre le jambon de fromage râpé.

Pose les 4 tranches de pain restantes et recouvre de beurre.

Fais cuire avec un croque-gaufre, à la poêle ou au four.

Sers chaud avec une salade verte.

## Instructions

### Option 2

Choose 1 of the 2 paintings by French artists provided.  
Find out what the French words are for the items of food in  
the painting and label it with the French words.

Use the online English-French dictionary to help.

Then do your own drawing or painting of some food in the

(it doesn't have to be the same food. Just use what you  
already have around the house)

Translate the recipe into English using the online  
French - English Collins dictionary to help you.

### Challenge task

Do another drawing or painting using the medium of pen and  
stippling (a technique where artists create shading and  
texture using small dots, typically made with ink, pencil, or  
paint) You could even choose one of the sentences below to  
say if you like the artists painting or not and why and maybe  
what you think of your own version.

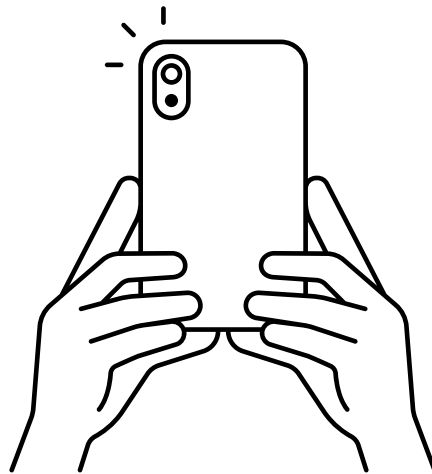

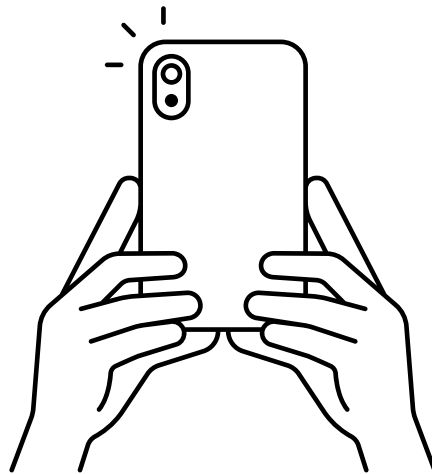
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# Claude Monet 'apples and grapes'



Stippling



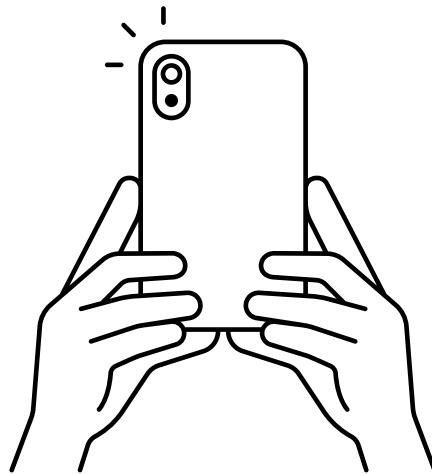
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# Cézanne

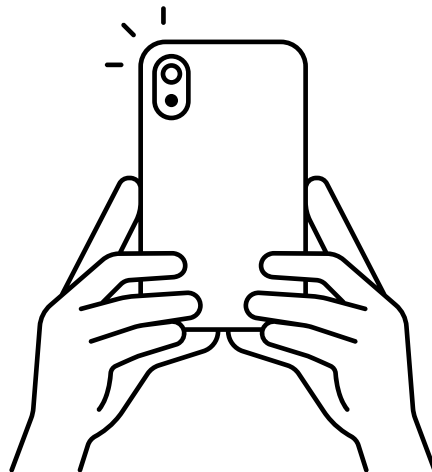

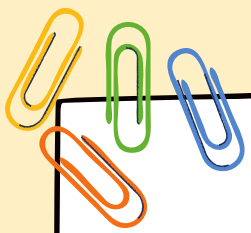
