You can choose how to present your work, as long as it clearly includes both history and geography information.

## Choose one of the 7 Wonders of the World:

- Great Wall of China (China)
- Petra (Jordan)
- Christ the Redeemer (Brazil)
- Machu Picchu (Peru)
- Chichén Itzá (Mexico)
- Colosseum (Italy)
- Taj Mahal (India)

## Things to consider:

- When was it built?
- Who built it?
- Why was it built?
- What was it used for in the past?
- Why is it historically important today?
- Where in the world is it located? (country, continent)
- What type of environment is it in? (mountains, desert, city, rainforest, etc.)
- How did the location affect how it was built or used?
- Include a map showing its location

## Your project should:

- Clearly explain both History and Geography
- Be well organised and easy to understand
- Include images, maps, or diagrams
- Use your own words
- Be neat, creative, and informative
