

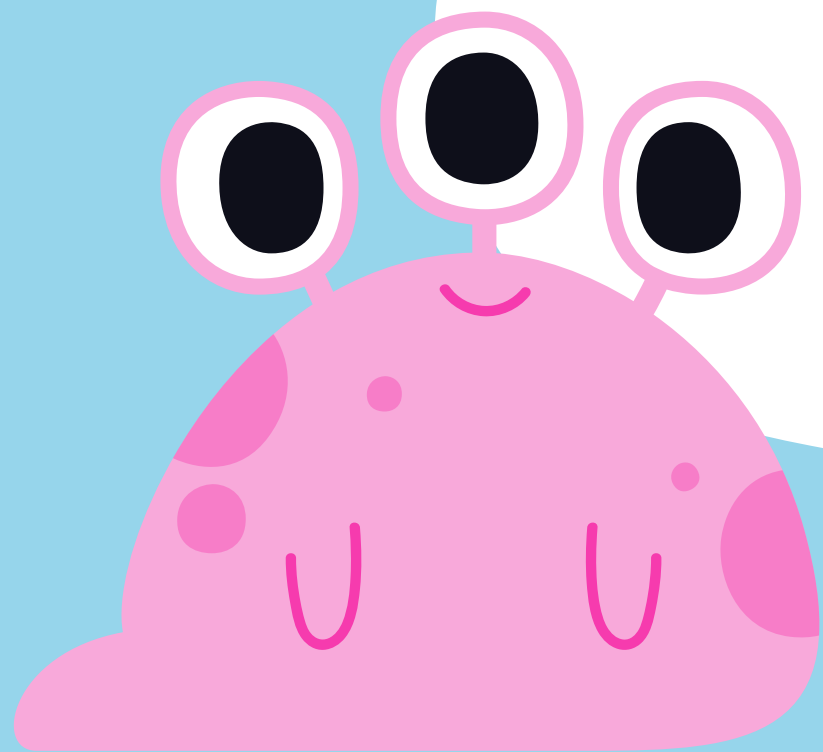

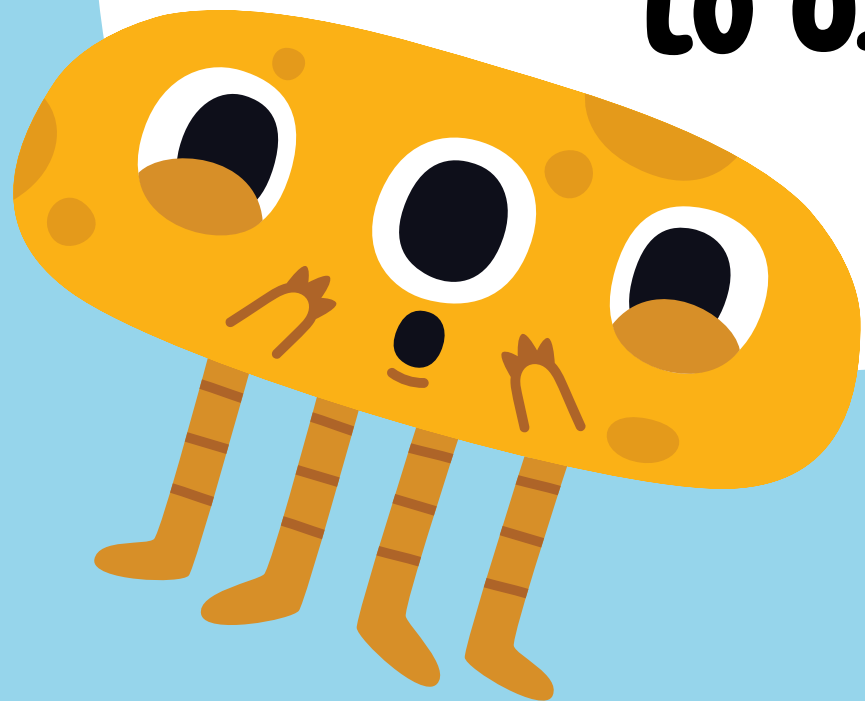

Expectations:

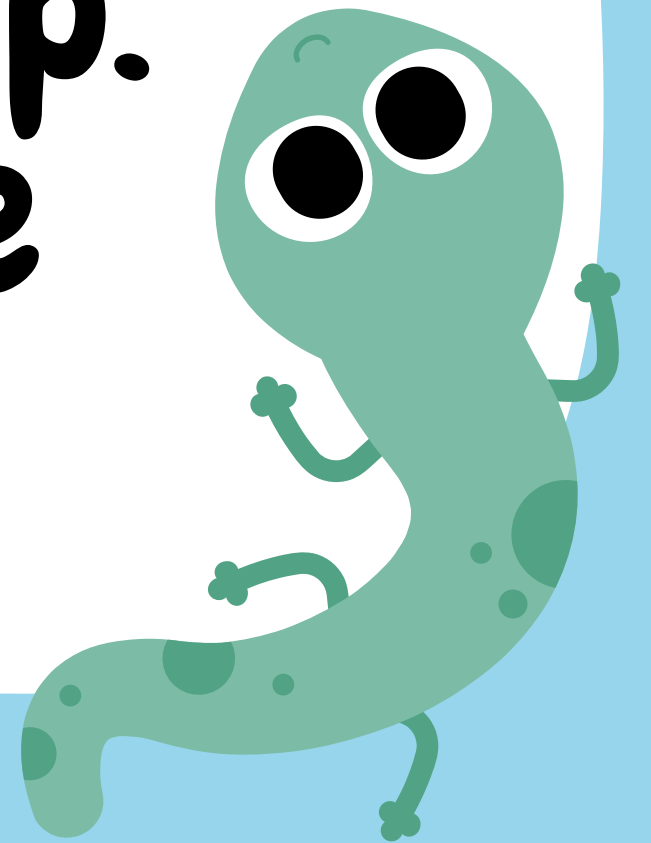
1. I will always share the deadline on Class Charts.

If a student is absent when the homework is set, they must still complete it for the deadline which is on ClassCharts and available from anywhere.

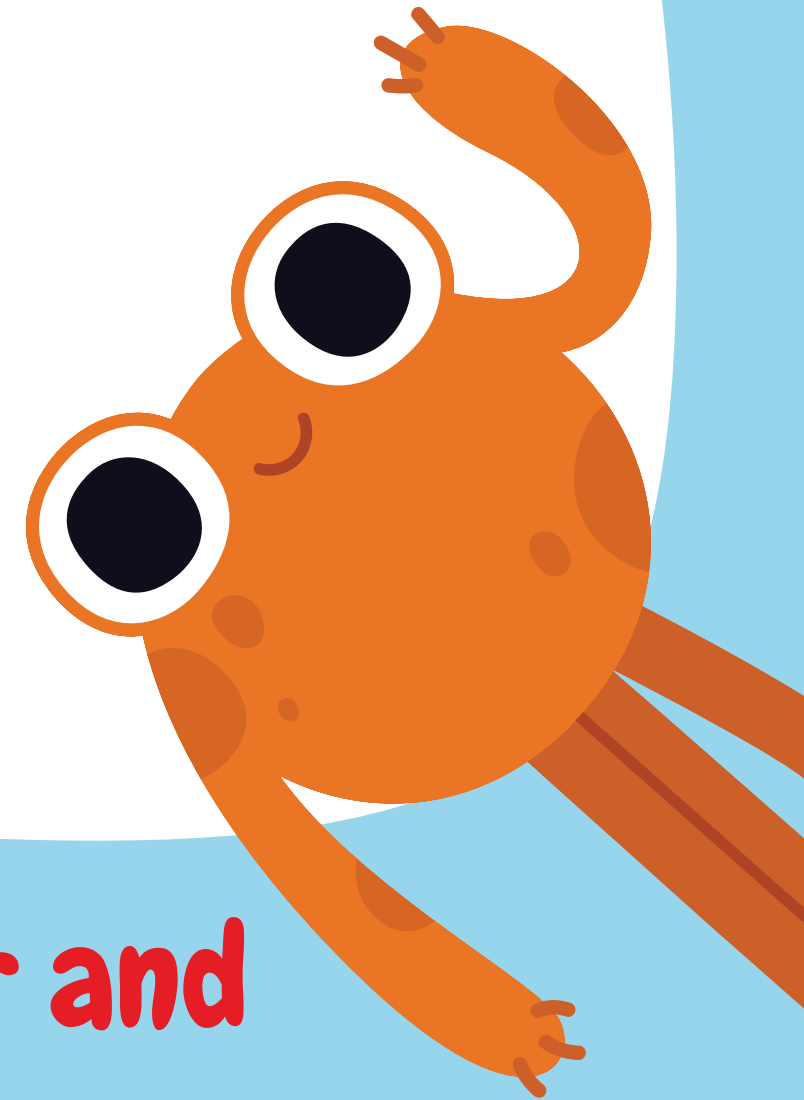


Do the right thing!





- all vocabulary and the English translation covered throughout the year under the various unit headings.**
- an extra 'stretch' section at the back of the Knowledge Organiser where students can attempt to use more complex language in their work.**

3. Encourage your child to practice their French by watching their favourite steaming shows with the language changed from English to French and adding English subtitles. Most streaming platforms will allow you to do this.

The more they have previously seen the show the better.



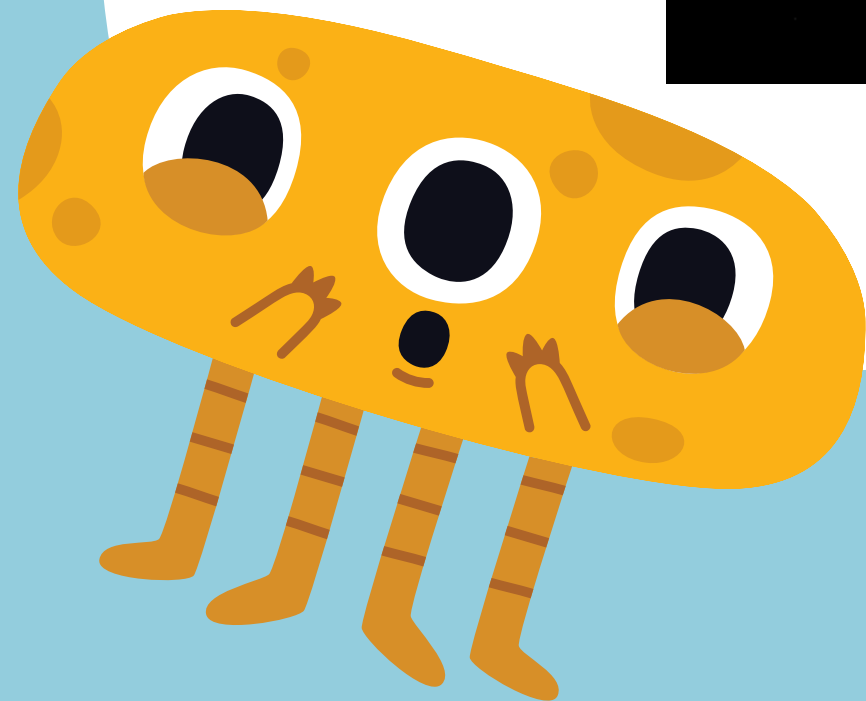
